This call for papers is dedicated to papers submitted to and presented at the IATBR 2024 conference in Vienna July 14-18, 2024 (https://iatbr2024.univie.ac.at/home/). Paper authors have been notified of their papers' preapproval and subsequent review following the Transportation Letters standards of publication.

This special issue showcases different but strongly related fields including the growing field of research in Mobility as a Service (MaaS), which is a maturing concept to integrate various forms of transportation services into a single system and related platform. This special issue is also dedicated to the idea of closing the service and system gap known as "first mile last mile." These two segments are the initial and final segments of a person's journey. New forms and services of transportation such as bike-sharing programs, electric scooters, and ride-sharing services are examples of technological innovations providing convenient modes to complement the more traditional public transportation options. In this special issue MaaS, new forms of travel, and vehicle technologies are combined in research explorations that use a variety of data analytic techniques in contexts from around the world.
